Founded in 1991, Greater Richmond SCAN (Stop Child Abuse Now) is a local nonprofit organization dedicated solely to the prevention and treatment of child abuse and neglect in the Greater Richmond area. SCAN helps keep children safe by providing the awareness, support and education needed to enhance the lives of children.

SCAN's Five Programs

- **The Family Support Program** provides weekly treatment and education groups for families who have experienced, or are at high risk of experiencing, child abuse or neglect. By reaching caregivers and children, the program promotes healthy recovery and also helps stop the cycle of abuse that is often passed down through generations.
- **Community Programs** encompass all of SCAN's prevention programs and initiatives that are at the community, state and organizational level. These programs are focused on the prevention of child maltreatment through the advancement of protective factors and trauma informed approaches in organizations, communities and systems.
- **The Richmond Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Program** recruits, trains, and supervises dedicated volunteers who advocate for the needs of abused, neglected, and at-risk children in juvenile dependency proceedings. Volunteers provide valuable insight into the child's life and assist the court in making informed decisions regarding the child's future.
- **The Circle Preschool** provides high quality early childhood education and intensive mental health treatment to children who are victims of abuse. The program works to reduce the long-term effects of traumatic abuse and neglect, resulting in improved results both in and out of the classroom.
- **The Child Advocacy Centers** use a multidisciplinary model to provide a variety of services to children in the legal system, including child forensic interviews, trauma focused mental health treatment, case management, and victim advocacy. This greatly reduces the trauma caused by the legal process, improves recovery, and results in better legal results.

SCAN primarily serves families from the cities of Richmond, Colonial Heights, and Petersburg and the counties of Chesterfield, Cumberland, Goochland, Hanover, Henrico, Louisa, New Kent, Powhatan and Prince George, in addition to other localities in Central VA.

During the July 2016 – June 2017 fiscal year, the Family Support Program served **321** caregivers and **108** children—all from families who have experienced or are at a high risk of experiencing child abuse and/or neglect. Our Richmond CASA volunteers advocated for **217** children in the Richmond Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court system. The CAC served **798** children who were alleged victims of severe physical abuse or neglect, child pornography or witnesses to violence, and **525** adults including their non-offending caregivers. The Circle Preschool Program served **17** children and **17** caregivers.

SCAN's Community Programs, including FAM (Families are Magic) and the TICN (Trauma-Informed Community Network), reached **864** adults through various trainings on how to recognize and report child abuse and neglect, trauma informed practices and positive parenting. SCAN's Community Programs also screened *Resilience* for over **1,900** individuals last fiscal year. *Resilience* is a documentary that delves into the science of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and a new movement to prevent and treat toxic stress.
